The principal objective of the ***IPT Scholarship*** program is to provide an introduction to the field for individuals who are considering or plan to pursue a career in state/local taxation, either in the public or private sector.

Student scholarships are available for up to \$2,000 in eligible costs associated with attending the IPT Annual Conference. The scholarship covers eligible travel and lodging expenses properly documented on an IPT reimbursement voucher. The Conference registration fee is waived for scholarship winners. Scholarships are available, on a limited basis, to full-time and part-time students, including teaching and research assistants in select degree programs who demonstrate a manifest interest in a career in state and local taxation. Award recipients are chosen by the IPT University Relations Committee.

IPT Annual Conference

The IPT Annual Conference is typically held in June/July. In addition to general sessions featuring keynote speakers, the program offers numerous general and breakout sessions focused on one of the four fields — state business income taxation, sales and use taxation, property taxation, and credits and incentives. Scholarship recipients may concentrate in one such field or attend sessions in all of them.
