

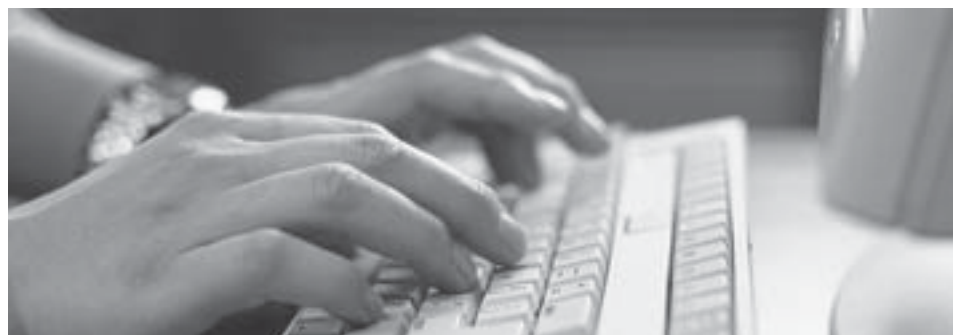

## Continuing Education Credit
